- 1. The completed application and cover page.
- A typed two-page minimum, three-page maximum, double-spaced essay titled:
 "Why were Historically Black Colleges and Universities created and what purpose do they serve today?"
- 3. A copy of your high school transcript which must include your first semester grades of the current school year.
- 4. A copy of your most recent S.A.T. or A.C.T. scores.
- 5. Financial Information:
 - a. A copy of your parents' or guardian's year 2023 tax return, including a copy of the W-2 form, OR
 - b. A completed copy of your F.A.F.S.A. form
 - c. *Note: Please redact sensitive personal identifiable information (PII), including social security numbers, prior to submitting W-2's or F.A.F.S.A forms
 - d. Must provide documentation for supplementary income (child support, alimony, social services, etc.)
- 6. Three (3) letters of recommendation.
